Challenge

The Nestlé factory at Waterswollows Road in Buxton Derbyshire is a newly built state of the art bottling facility which has undergone internal design changes. The Nestlé team had organised a high profile VIP opening of the factory by the worldwide chairman of the Nestlé food group.

The mezzanine floor had an observation deck required for the event, incorporating an extended workshop and store room. Access was a major issue as the factory had engineers on site installing a bottling plant during our contract. Building Projects ensured that the bottling engineers' work was not in any way impeded.

Solution

Building Projects (UK) approached the project with cost and time saving suggestions, leading the client's design team to provide a spectacular event room which received the highest praise from all attending the event.

- Construction of ground floor mezzanine observation deck
